

Degree Overview

- 25 units, letter graded (12 technical, 5 capstone, 8 leadership)
- Pass MEng Comprehensive Exam (2 Parts: Leadership & Tech)
- Grade Point Average (GPA) 3.0 minimum to graduate
- Graduate students must repeat courses for which they received a grade below C- if a passing grade in the course is required as part of the degree program. Note: *Department requirements may be higher (EECS is higher)*



Important Dates

- Registration for new graduate opens: July 15
 Note: Check Calcentral for your exact enrollment date and time.
- Tuition due (20% or in full): August 19
- All graduate students must be registered by the end of the third week of classes; MEng students must be registered for 2 units of boot camp by August 1
- Required Boot Camp instruction begins: August 10
- Regular in-person (semester long) instruction begins: August 24


CalCentral Enrollment Process: Searching for classes





CalCentral Class "Shopping Cart"




Add courses to your "Shopping Cart" now to save them until it is time to enroll. You are not enrolled and seats are not saved until you check out!

Billing & Payment

Tuition and Fees

- Set rate for full time students, any number of units
- Grant & awards will post by mid August (usually 1-2 days before your semester bill
- first payment due by August 19, 2022
- Pay at least 20% of your total semester bill (if enrolled in the fee payment plan) to be considered registered
- If you received an award and you decide to pay your tuition before award is disbursed, manually **deduct** semester award amount before paying your tuition bill

(Non-Residents) = \$31,195.25


(CA Residents) = \$27,072.75
