

Degree Overview

- 25 units, letter graded (12 technical, 5 capstone, 8 leadership)
- Pass MEng Comprehensive Exam (2 Parts: Leadership & Tech)
- Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) 3.0 minimum to graduate
 - Note: *Department requirements may be higher (EECS is higher)*
- Graduate students must repeat courses for which they received a grade below C- if a passing grade in the course is required as part of the degree program.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress and standing

ENGIN 270C Teaming & Project Management 1 unit	 Fixed meeting times Meets weekly for 1 hour 8 weeks long (starts in September)



Important Dates

- Registration for new graduate opens: July 14, 2023
 Note: Check Calcentral for your exact enrollment date and time.
- Tuition due (20% or in full): **August 18, 2023**
- Full Time and continuing Part Time MEng students must be registered for 2 units of boot camp by August 1, 2023
- Required Fall Boot Camp instruction begins: August 9-18, 2023 (excluding weekends)
- Regular in-person (semester long) instruction begins: August 23, 2023

What do I enroll in later?

- Capstone Project (ENGIN 296MA)

- There will be no waitlists for leadership classes






CalCentral Enrollment Process: Searching for classes





CalCentral Class "Shopping Cart"




Add courses to your "Shopping Cart" now to save them until it is time to enroll. You are not enrolled and seats are not saved until you check out!

Billing & Payment

Tuition and Fees

- Set rate for full time students, any number of units
- Grant & awards will post by early to mid August (usually 1-2 days before your semester bill)
- first payment due by August 18, 2023
- Pay at least 20% of your total semester bill (if enrolled in the fee payment plan) to be considered registered
- If you received an award and you decide to pay your tuition before award is disbursed, manually **deduct** semester award amount before paying your tuition bill

(Non-Residents) = \$32,304


(CA Residents) = \$27,482
