 - Pass MEng Comprehensive Exam (2 Parts: Leadership & Tech)
 - Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) 3.0 minimum to graduate
 - **Note:** *Department requirements may be higher (EECS is higher)*
 - Graduate students must repeat courses for which they received a grade below C- if a passing grade in the course is required as part of the degree program.
 - Maintain satisfactory academic progress and standing, which includes graduating within two semesters

ENGIN 295 Communications for Engineering Leaders 1 unit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fixed meeting times • Meets for 15 weeks for 1-hr/wk, 10 for 1.5hr/wk, or 7 for 2-hr/wk • Pay close attention to meeting dates/times/length (varies based on section)
ENGIN 270C Teaming & Project Management 1 unit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fixed meeting times • Meets weekly for 1 hour • 8 weeks long (starts in September)
ENGIN 296MA Capstone 2 units	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No fixed meeting class times • Weekly meetings are determined by your project advisor and your teammates. • Capstone staff will enroll students in temporary section until matched with a team • Note: No final grade in Fall, will show as IP = In Progress at end of fall semester.

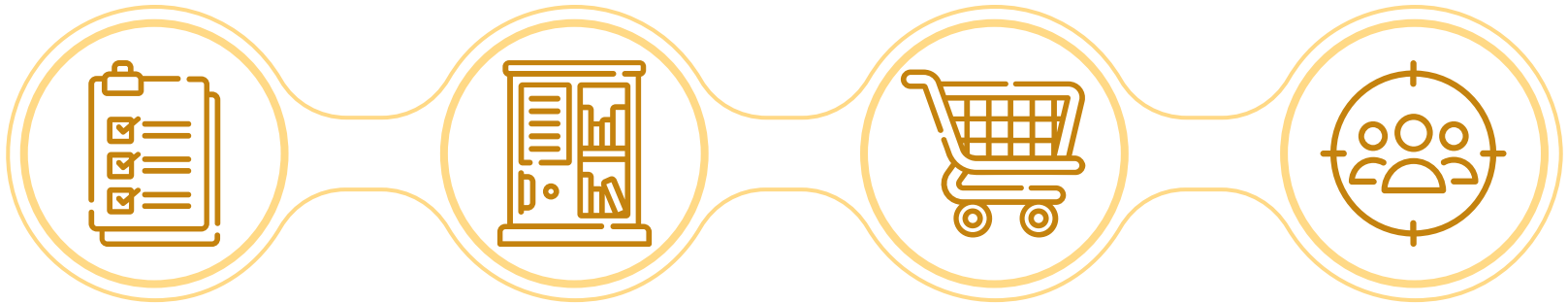

End of July: Final project descriptions released.

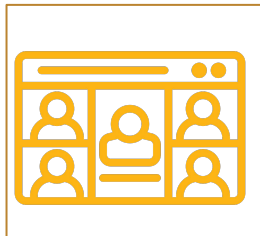
AUGUST

- Registration for new graduate opens: **July 19, 2024**
Note: Check Calcentral for your exact enrollment date and time.
- Tuition due (20% if payment plan or in full): **August 23, 2024**
- Full Time and continuing Part Time MEng students must be registered for 2 units of boot camp by **August 4, 2024**
- Required Fall Boot Camp instruction begins: **August 13-22, 2024 (excluding weekends)**
- Regular in-person (semester long) instruction begins: **August 28, 2024**



Tuition and Fees

- Set rate for full time students, any number of units
 - Grant & awards will post by early to mid August (usually 1-2 days before your semester bill)
 - first payment due by **August 23, 2024**
 - Pay at least 20% of your total semester bill (if enrolled in the fee payment plan) to be considered registered
 - If you received an award and you decide to pay your tuition before award is disbursed, manually **deduct** semester award amount before paying your tuition bill
